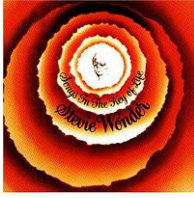


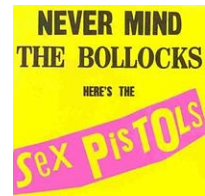
Top Albums of 1975-1985

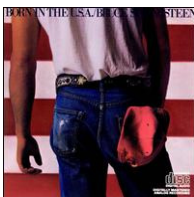
